



# ESSER Fund-Based Recovery Programs

Since March of 2020 the federal government has passed three relief bills in regards to rebuilding K-12 education post pandemic. Combined, legislation provides more than \$193 billion in aid to state education agencies (SEAs) which must subaward 87.5–90% to school districts. An additional \$9.7 billion has been directed to governors to spend at their discretion and support private schools.
